Proposed correction and amendments of FIBB Bylaws

Correction to Bylaws...(omission in transcribing/retyping from original copy)

Article III, No. 2 insert at the end of line 7 the following...

“the officers and...”

Proposed Amendment to the FIBB Bylaws...

Note: Amendments to the Bylaws requires a majority vote of approval by the general membership provided that the proposed amendments or changes have been sent out in the notice of the meeting;

Article III, No. 2...insert the following...

...”each elected officer and director shall serve a one year term coinciding with the beginning and end of the physical year or until their successor shall have been duly elected, whichever event is later.”

Article III, No. 2. ...add the following...

“No officer or director shall serve more than 2 consecutive years in the same office or capacity with the exception of the office of treasurer.”

Article IV, No. 2...Insert the following...

...”coinciding with the beginning and end of the physical year or until their successor shall have been duly elected, whichever event is later.”

Article IV, No. 2... add the following...

“No officer shall serve more than 2 consecutive years in the same office or capacity with the exception of the office of the treasurer.”

Article VI – Fiscal Year...delete the following...

...upon filing of the tax return of the corporation...

Add new Article XI – Parliamentary Authority

“The rules contained in the current edition of Roberts Rules of Order shall govern the organization in all cases to which they are applicable and in which they are not inconsistent with these bylaws and any special rules of order the organization may adopt.”

Add new Article XII – Middle School Band Associate Membership

Any parent of a middle school student from either Gifford Middle School or Oslo Middle School who is a paid member of their respective middle school’s band booster organization is automatically granted the

status of Associate Member of the Fighting Indians Band Boosters, Inc. and is exempt from payment of the FIBB membership dues.
